CLL: Literacy. I.C.T.

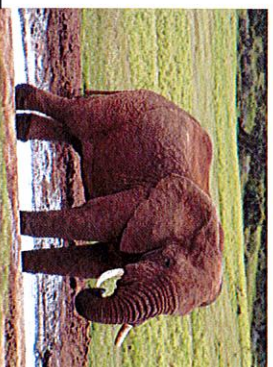
- Explanation writing-den building, fact files about the continent of Africa, people and animals, wild animal brochures, guided reading- African folk tales/fiction and non-fiction focus, retelling folk and traditional tales, comparing European and African stories and writing.
- Programming BeeBot 'Handa' around an African maze, designing African animal patterns, using GoogleEarth to locate African landmarks, creating databases and bar charts.

- People- Nelson Mandela, Tutankhamun, Howard Carter, Egyptian kings, Maasai people.
- Time and place- Apartheid in South Africa, Discovery of Tutankhamun, the pyramids, Recycling/ reusing gardens.
- Geography- The continents, finding Africa, famous landmarks, eco-systems and nature, sustainability.

Maths and Science

- Measure- weighing- cooking dishes from African countries.
- Word problems- African animal theme.
- Handling data- Creating African animal zoo database and bar charts.
- Symmetry and shape- creating African masks, animal patterns.
- Position and direction- programming 'Handa' BeeBots.
- Science- Living things and habitats, comparing Laverstock and African wildlife/Habitats, visit to Riverbourne Farm.



Arts and Design: Art, Music, P.E. and D.T

- Art- mandala designs, pop art silhouettes.
- DT- Den building, egg box tortoisies, tyre garden, designing and making African kikoy wraps, planting and growing seeds/plants.
- Music- Chanting traditional songs, using percussion instruments to make music, playing traditional African percussion instruments.
- P.E. - Kenyan/Maasai dancing, monkey puzzle gymnastics.

Physical and Emotional Wellbeing: Games, Gym, PSHCE.

- Physical education- working together to create dance routines. Team play in dodgeball and other ball games.
- Cookery- healthy treats and snacks. Food from other cultures. Pancakes.
