Skeleton pictures using black paper and art straws

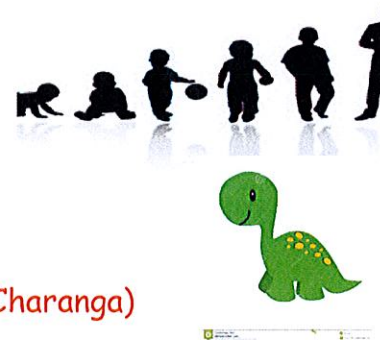
Thaumatrope and tumbling acrobat
