1/3	Fair Trade Fortnight 'Choose The World You Want' 4/3 World Book Day	Fairtrade Fortnight 2021 Virtual Visit from a Fairtrade Speaker	Colossians 4:1	Use a 'regular' and a Fairtrade product and some toy money to demonstrate how the money we pay for different product is distributed. Show how Fairtrade products benefit the producers and give them a fair wage for their efforts. Explain that many Fairtrade products are now available and that the extra that they may cost means someone gets a better deal. Share the symbol and some products it can be found on. Reflect on the idea of stewardship - choosing the world we want - how the planet, and its living things should be cared for.	Mon - KW - Bubble Fri - Bubble 3 and 4 sharing

Friday is red nose day, so during the week let's share what makes us laugh and feel happy. Reflect on things that we are looking forward to. 22/3	Symbols of Christianity	Christian Symbols	Genesis 9: 8-17	First, look at symbols in everyday life and how they represent something. Show some logos and get the children to talk about what they represent, and explain the link if they can. Christian symbols are very much like this, they remind us of something important about Christianity. Select a few symbols to investigate and reflect on over the week. Key symbols to focus on might include the cross, the candle, the fish, the dove, the rainbow and bread and wine.	Mon - KW - Bubble Fri - Cl3 & 6 sharing
