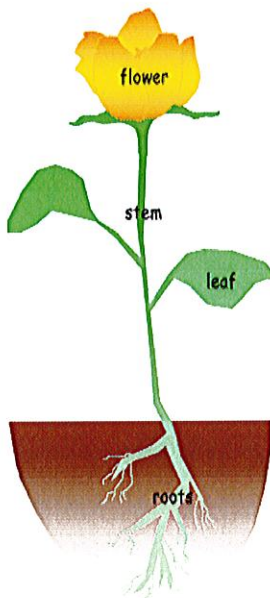

Growing



Plants and vegetables are planted into soil.

Roots will grow down into the soil.

They need water and sunlight to grow.

You must wash your hands after gardening.

Most plants will have roots, a stem, leaves and flowers made up of petals.

Vegetables can be eaten - some need to be cooked first.

Mini beasts



Caterpillars- They hatch from an egg and they eat constantly.



Bumblebees- They are an insect with 6 legs. They collect nectar from flowers.



Ladybirds- They are an insect with 6 legs. Their wing cases are symmetrical.

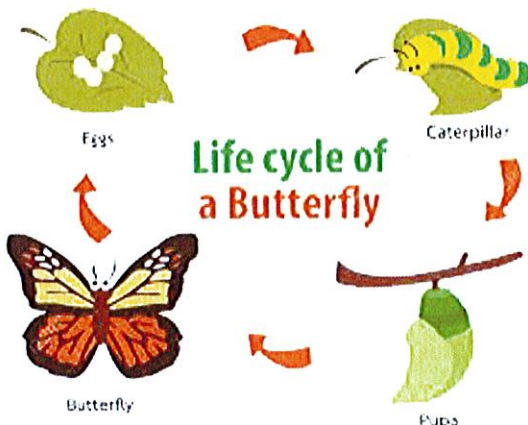


Butterflies- They are an insect and have 4 wings. They taste through their feet.



Dragonflies- They are insects with 6 legs and have 2 pairs of wings.

Life cycle of a Butterfly



The butterfly lays an egg on a leaf.

A small caterpillar comes out of the egg.

The caterpillar eats almost constantly.

The caterpillar makes a cocoon.

This is then called a pupa or chrysalis.

The butterfly emerges out of the cocoon.

The butterfly eats and flies around.

The butterfly lays an egg.
