4/9	Learning and Doing Our Best	Doing Your Best	Corinthians 9:24-25	Share some inspirational quotes from the story page. Discuss together, when is it easy to do our best? (A task we like, a subject we enjoy.) What are the challenges to doing our best? To be a 'Bubbling Learner' we need to try out best all the time, and this requires effort. 11/9	Life and Teachings of Jesus Equality	Zaccheus	James 2:2-4	Watch the BBC clip linked on the left. How did people feel about Zaccheus at the start of the story and why? 18/9	Old Testament Characters- Abraham	One Starry Night	Genesis 12:1-3	Read the first part of the story. If you were asked to do this, would you? Could you? What would you worry about? Why didn't Abraham worry? Read the end of the story and explain that Abraham did have a family as God said. Sometimes we need to have faith and belief.	1,2,3 - EP 4,5,6 - CD Hymn Practice
25/9	Thankfulness (Friday 1:30pm – Harvest Festival)	Be Thankful	Colossians 3:15-17	Adapt the story on the left so it is child friendly (about birthday gifts, or pocket money.) Sometimes we forget to be thankful for the wonderful things we experience and have. Make a list of things we should be thankful for, but often forget.	1,2,3 - DR 4,5,6 - AH Sharing – 1,3,5
2/10	Old Testament Characters- Moses	The 10 Commandments	Joshua 1:7-8	Discuss who Moses was (leader chosen by God.) Reflect on the stories we heard in 'Open The Book' last year. Look at the story of Moses receiving the 10 Commandments on the link. Why do we think he was chosen to receive the rules? 9/10	Courage	David and Goliath	Isaiah 1:10-14	What do the class think courage is? Ask someone to find a definition. Share a time when you have had to be courageous in order to overcome a fear. What did you think, feel and do? Describe how it worked. Give/act out some scenarios that require courage and ask the class to offer encouragement and advice. 16/10	Life and Teachings of Jesus-Faith	Believe what you feel	John 14:6	The Bible tells us that faith in God will provide for us. We show faith in many ways, and it is very much like trust.
