30/10	Honesty	Honesty	1 Peter 3: 10-12	Remember that Honesty is one of our school values that we were all involved in reviewing last year. Explore the concept that it can take courage to be honest, especially if we've made a mistake. Why might people be tempted to fib? Why is honesty the right thing if it feels difficult? Role play scenarios 2 ways: honest/dishonest. E.g. haven't done homework, broke something expensive accidentally. 13/11	Anti – Bullying (13 th – 17 th Nov)	BBC Clips	Romans 12: 20-21	Resources for assemblies (and follow up lessons) should be available on this website from mid-October. The theme this year is 'Power for Good.' Use a clip from the BBC selection that is age appropriate to open discussion about bullying. 20/11	Trust	Hannah's Bike Ride	Proverbs 3: 5-6	Reflect back to honesty, and discuss how this links to trust. We know we can trust people who are honest with themselves and others. Get a volunteer to choose a partner whom they trust. Blindfold them and then ask the partner to direct them across the room. How does it feel to trust someone or to be trusted? 27/11	St Andrew (30th November)	Story of St Andrew	Matthew 4: 18-22	See if anyone can recall a bible story that has St Andrew in it, before watching the clip. (Feeding the 5,000.) How do we celebrate St Andrew's day at school? How is it celebrated in Scotland where he is the patron saint? Discuss other countries that have St Andrew as their patron saint, and how they celebrate his day.	1,2,3 - RC 4,5,6 - AH Sharing – 2,4,6
4/12	Advent	Advent Wreath	Isaiah 40: 9-11	What does Advent mean? (Waiting) What are we waiting for? It may seem like we're waiting for Father Christmas, family visits, presents etc, but what are we really waiting for? Use the clip on the left to explain the significance of the advent ring we will have in worship over the next four weeks.	1,2,3 - EP 4,5,6 - JE Hymn Practice
11/12	Christmas - Peace	Peace on Earth	Isaiah 9: 6-7	Look at the meaning of the different elements of Christmas as shown here . Reflect on how we often forget the true meaning. Round off by looking at the story on the clip 'Peace on Earth.'	1,2,3 – DR 4,5,6 - CD
