As Mathematicians we will...

- look at different ways of sorting and grouping objects.
- develop our understanding of place value up to 10.
- become secure with our number bonds to 10.
- form all digits correctly.
- add and subtract numbers within 10.

As Scientists we will

- learn about our body, naming key parts.
- look at our 5 senses and develop an awareness for their importance.
- study the season of Autumn observing the changes in weather and the environment around us.

As Readers we will...

- read 'The Twits' by Roald Dahl as our class chapter book.
- study a variety of superhero stories and develop our inference skills by predicting what may happen next.
- explore non-fiction texts linked to the human body.

As Writers we will...

- begin to form simple sentences using capital letters and full stops.
- use alliteration to describe super powers.
- write poetry linked to our senses.
- write thank you letters to visitors linked to our topic.

As Artists we will

- look carefully about the details of the human face.
- draw self-portraits and portraits of others using a range of drawing materials and 3D art.

As Designers and Makers we will

- develop our construction skills by designing and building our own models using recycling.
- use outdoor materials to build structures to develop our role play.

As Sportspeople we will ...

- develop our hand-eye coordination by playing a range of ball based activities.
- look at the qualities that makes a successful sportsperson, both individually and within a team.
