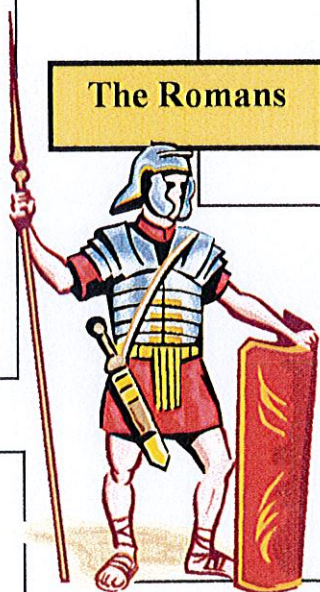
Produce a PowerPoint presentation about Romans in Britain
