

Foundation Subjects

History: Children will be learning about life in Egypt, ancient and modern, with a focus on the rulers of Ancient Egypt. They will research and produce a holiday brochure which will include maps, illustrations, facts, opinions and prices. **RE:** The work for this term is based on the book, 'I am David' by Anne Holm where we follow David's journey from captivity to freedom and his discovery of God along the way. **Art:** Our art focus is 'Drawing' where the children will have the opportunity to explore a range of materials and techniques including the use of light and shade. They will also have the opportunity to evaluate their own work and comment upon the work of established artists. **MUSIC:** Children will be investigating a range of rhythmic patterns with a view to composing, improving and performing their own compositions using a variety of instruments. They will also study musical notation. **PE:** In gymnastics, they will explore symmetry in shape and movement. They will create sequences on the floor and transfer their work to apparatus. In games, children will take part in football, netball and basketball activities. Some children will have the opportunity to participate in a local schools' basketball tournament. **ICT:** Children will use the computer to research information about Ancient Egypt and to collate this information to produce a Powerpoint presentation using animation and a range of graphics. **DT:** Children will be linking their work in Design & Technology to the History topic where they will have the opportunity to plan, design, make and evaluate their own work.

Children will be expected to learn weekly tables (where appropriate) and to read each evening. A homework task will be given weekly and recorded in their homework diaries.
