Dear Parents

Next Monday (15th January) Class 6 and Class 2 have been invited to visit Salisbury Cathedral as part of their programme of educational events. The children will take part in a range of activities within the cathedral and will also be given a tour. With your permission, photographs will be taken during the visit for use in the Cathedral's promotional materials.

We will be leaving school at 9:00am to walk to the cathedral, and on arrival we will have a snack. Following this, we will take part in a range of activities before having a packed lunch, which we will take with us. If you have already ordered a school meal for Monday, this will be cancelled and refunded. Children who are entitled to free school meals can be provided with a packed lunch by Mrs Carpenter if required – please ask Mrs Carpenter by Thursday 11th January if this is required.

After lunch, we will take part in further activities before leaving the Cathedral at 2pm to walk back to school. There is no charge for this visit.

If you agree to your child taking part in this educational visit, please give your permission by clicking the Authorise button on this email in the school app. If you have any problems using the app, please just pop in to see Mrs Poynting, Mrs Morgan or Miss Hodgson to give permission. We will send a separate email to request permission for photographs to be taken during the visit.

Class 2 will also need some additional adults to accompany them for the day, both during the walk and for the time in the cathedral. If you are available to help, please would you let us know (either by email, phone or by popping in to see one of us) so that we can ensure that we can make the necessary arrangements.

On the day, please make sure that children are wearing shoes that are comfortable for the walk. If it is rainy, please also send in a spare pair of footwear and socks so that they are comfortable for the whole day. School uniform should be worn. If it is cold or rainy, please ensure that a suitable coat is provided, along with hats and gloves.
