Dear Parents,

On **Tuesday 20th May**, Year 6 will be visiting the Boscombe Down Aviation Collection (BDAC) at the Old Sarum Airfield. This visit will enrich the pupils' learning of our current topic, 'The Home Front' during World War II. Importantly, it will deepen their understanding of the historical significance of the Salisbury area and its connections to aviation.

Throughout the day, children will learn about the history of aviation and the airfield, view scale models of aircraft and artillery, and sit in the cockpit of a Lancaster Bomber. They will also have the opportunity to try flight simulators and explore the cockpits of planes and helicopters from different eras. Museum staff will guide us through the exhibits to ensure a valuable learning experience.

We will travel by coach, leaving school at 9:20 am. Pupils will need to bring a packed lunch, which will be eaten either outside (weather permitting) or indoors, where seating will be provided. To maximise the experience, the class will be divided into small groups. The visit will be supervised by the Year 6 staff team and an additional member of the governing body. We expect to return before the end of the school day.

Thanks to the generous contribution from the Friends of St. Andrews, the cost of travel and admission has been kept to a minimum. A **voluntary contribution of £9 per child** will cover the expenses for this exciting trip.

Consent and payment can be completed online via the school app. On the day, children should wear their usual school uniform and bring a packed lunch and water. If your child receives free school meals, Mrs. Carpenter can provide a packed lunch upon request (please order by Monday 12th).
