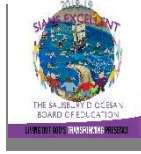

Dear Parents/Carers

In Term 6, our enquiry question is 'Why did people travel in the past?'. As part of this enquiry, we will be learning about modes of transport. We will focus on the Titanic, a very famous mode of transport that set sail on its voyage from Southampton, our local area.

To enhance their learning, Class 3 will be visiting the SeaCity Museum in Southampton. We will be participating in a discovery session called 'Southampton's Titanic Story' and an expert led workshop called 'Life on board the Titanic'. We will draw on our learning about sources and investigate first-hand accounts/primary sources and artefacts that the museum has to offer.

We will travel to and from the museum by coach, within school hours. The children will need to bring a packed lunch and water bottle in a small backpack that they can carry for the day. Please remember no fizzy drinks and ensure the lunch is nut free. Children should wear their school uniform, but comfortable footwear is advised (trainers).

To cover the cost of the trip and the coach we are asking for a contribution of £14.30 per pupil.

We hope these activities will help enrich the children's learning and be an experience they reflect on in years to come.
