- -Write instructions on 'How to save an Osprey' and use technical language.
- -Focus on imagery, using a range of figurative language in our writing so that we can create a vivid picture in the readers' minds.

As Mathematicians we will

- -Develop our number and place-value knowledge.
- -Learn how to compare, order and calculate with decimal fractions (decimals).
- -Use this knowledge and apply it to calculate with money.

As **Scientists** we will

- -Look at separating mixtures and solutions, and also study reversible and irreversible changes.
- -Investigate everyday materials and compare their properties and uses.

As geographers we will..

Explore the physical geography of the UK. And find out about the natural resources available to us, and also their uses.

Explore how energy as electricity is generated.
