AREAS OF LEARNING



As **Readers** we will explore a range of text types, developing a deeper understanding and learning skills needed to deduce information using clues within the text. We will also make justified predictions and develop our questioning skills. Our class text for Term 4 is 'Anglo-Saxon Boy' by Tony Bradman.

As **Writers** we will identify key features of text types and apply them within our own writing. The key text types that we will focus on are information texts about an Anglo-Saxon warrior, and then build on this in a viewpoint narrative about a battle between Anglo-Saxons and Vikings.

As **Mathematicians** we will continue our focus on understanding and manipulating multiplicative relationships and then begin looking at coordinates.

We will continue our mastering numbers sessions as part of our daily times tables recall practice leading up to the MTC.

As **Sportspeople** we will develop our knowledge and skills in Athletics

We will also take part in cricket with the sports coach.

As **Historians** we will be learning about the history of the Viking invasion of Britain, looking at the Viking and Anglo-Saxon way of life, and how they settled in Britain.

As **Geographers** we will develop our knowledge of where the Vikings, Normans, and Anglo-Saxons lived, and consider why place names are now what they are, based on history's influence.

The key question we will investigate in RE is: '

How does the teaching of the gurus move Sikhs from dark to light?'

As **Musicians** we will learn how to play the recorder. We will also learn how to follow a beat, read musical symbols and compose our own body percussion pieces.

As **Computer Scientists** we will be focussing on Data logging, using data we collect to log and analyse.
