We looked at how God made the Heavens and the Earth and everything within them. He also gave us the gift of being able to 'create' ourselves. Reflect on what we are 'creative' with. Celebrate our creativity and share some things that we have been able to create because of this gift. 17/11	<b>Prayer</b>	Christian prayer	Philippians 4:6	<p>Introduce the concept of prayer with some basic explanation. Prayer is part of all major faiths. Talk about how every person who prays does so in their own way. People sometimes go to special places to pray: church, synagogue, mosque. Discuss how some people find it easier to pray in the open, when they are walking, or sitting in a quiet place.</p> <p>Some people use special aids to help them to concentrate. Show the items from the display, e.g. using a prayer mat or a prayer wheel, a rosary or holding a special object like a stone. Some people like to focus on a candle, a cross, an icon or some beautiful flowers. Why did God give his only son the world? (Because He loved the world.) What gifts will we be giving this year and why? Hopefully we will have helped make a box for the Trussell Trust to take to Eastern Europe to show someone there that they are loved. Collect examples of how we will show love to our family and friends this Christmas. Do we have to give something physical to show our love? What else could we 'give' that would show our love? (Time, companionship, a smile or a hug, kind words or thoughts etc.) Relate to the gifts in the 4 <sup>th</sup> verse of ' <a href="#">In the bleak midwinter.</a> ' (Could be used as a prayer.)
