AREAS OF LEARNING



As Mathematicians we will...

- look at different ways of sorting and grouping objects.
- develop our understanding of place value up to 10.
- become secure with our number bonds to 10.
- form all digits correctly.

As Artists we will

- explore mark making using different materials such as charcoal, pencil, chalk and watercolours
- mix and match colours, particularly looking at the colours of the different seasons and weather
- explore simple printing techniques

As **Scientists** we will

- study the seasons, looking in particular at Autumn, observing the changes in weather and the environment around us.
- -Look at ways to record the weather, such as measuring rainfall with simple equipment

As **Designers** and **Makers** we will

- develop our construction skills by designing and building our own weather measuring devices
- use outdoor materials to build structures to develop our role play.

As **Readers** we will...

- sharing a variety of stories and develop our inference skills by predicting what may happen next.
- explore fiction and non-fiction texts linked to the weather.
- explore and share a variety of different books during book enjoyment time

As **Computer**

Scientists we will

- become more familiar with the different components of a computer
- -develop our keyboard and mouse skills
- explore a range of apps on the IPADs.

As Writers we will...

- begin to form simple sentences
 using capital letters and full stops.
- use adjectives to describe the weather.
- -Create simple non-fiction texts about the weather
- write labels for our construction toy creations

As Geographers we will

- name and locate the four countries of the UK and their capital cities
- learn that the UK has seasonal weather patterns with cold winters and hot summers
- -learn about hot and cold climates and the equator
- -look at different types of extreme weather

In **RE** this term we are focusing on Christianity. The key question we will investigate is: Who made the World?

As **Musicians** we will

- -sing and clap different rhythms
- -listen to music and compose group music using instruments
