



As **Historians** we will continue learning about prehistoric changes. We will consider closely how some of these changes happened in our local area and the impact this has had on our how we live today in Salisbury.

As **Scientists** we will explore our topic of 'Light and Dark'. We will learn about light sources and sun safety. We will be asking and investigation the answers to questions such as: How are shadows made? How do they change? How does light reflect from sur-

As **Linguists** we will learn hobbies and activities to explain what we enjoy doing.

AREAS OF LEARNING

As **Readers** we will analyse a range of genres to broaden our reading skills.

We will continually explore new vocabulary as well as learning a new skill of summarising.

As **Writers** we will Focus on fiction writing. We will be using Leon and the Place Between as our key text. We will then think about setting descriptions, dialogues and re-writing the story from an alternative perspective.

We will then complete a non-fiction unit on poster writing. We will create wanted posters and think

As **Mathematicians** we will look at multiplication and division. We will revisit known strategies before learning new strategies to multiply and divide 2 digit numbers.

As **Sports people** we will learn the sports Netball and Tennis. One session a week will be lead by the sports coach. We will learn the rules and key skills needed before playing the games.

As **artists** we will be exploring the medium of collage. We will learn about Nick Gentry and use his works to inspire our own collages.

As **Computer Scientists** we will learn about branching databases, and create our own, linked with our science learning.

In PSHE we will be thinking about Rights and Respect. We will understand the difference between fact and opinion and know ways of deciphering between fact and opinion and checking the reliability of 'facts'.
