Tropic of	The parallel of latitude that is 23½ degrees south of the equator and		
Capricorn	is the southernmost latitude reached by the overhead sun.		
Deforestation	The action of clearing a wide area of trees.		
Wet season	The time of year when most of a region's average annual rainfall occurs.		
Endangered	Seriously at risk of extinction.		
Forest floor	The bottom layer of the trees in the rainforest.		
Understory Layer	The underlying layer of vegetation in a forest.		
Canopy Layer	The upper layer or habitat zone of a forest.		
Emergent Layer	The top of the rainforest where trees, plants, and leaves obtain the most sunlight.
