Areas of Learning

As **Readers** we will...

- Read 'Some Places More Than Others' a fictional text, linked to our enquiry.
- Read a range of non-fiction texts, including travel brochures focusing on America.

As **Writers** we will...

- Write for a range of purposes to support the creation of our 'Suitcase Project' linking to our class text.
- Write and perform poetry, showing understanding through intonation and tone.

As **Mathematicians** we will...

- Understand, explore and calculate using factors, multiples and prime numbers.
- Develop our understanding of fractions, including multiplication and finding equivalent decimal numbers.

As **geographers** we will...

- Understand geographical similarities and differences through the study of human and physical geography of Salisbury, a region in a European country and a region in North or South America.

As **Engineers** we will...

- Use textiles according to their functional properties and aesthetic qualities.
- Communicate ideas through a range of materials and components.

As **philosophers** we will....

- Consider key questions such as:
What makes us unique?
Should everyone speak the same language?
What are human rights and are they the same across the world?

As **musicians** we will...

- Explore the music of Bali through 2 different musical forms. We will explore the use of rhythm in these 2 styles of music.

As **computer scientists** we will ...

- Use physical computing to explore the concept of selection in programming through the use of the Crumble programming environment.

As **athletes** we will...

- Develop our ability and techniques within swimming.
- Learn the skills and techniques needed for tennis, developing our hand-eye coordination.
