AREAS OF LEARNING



As **Readers** we will.....

- Study how direct and reported speech are used in narratives.
- Read Shakespeare's Story of Macbeth.
- Read play scripts and perform from them.
- Read stories with Tudor Characters and settings (The Ghost of Thomas Kempe - P Lively.)
- Read non fiction texts to research Tudor life.

As **Writers** we will.....

- Write play scripts, reported speech and direct speech.
- Write journalistic reports using a variety of tones and grammatical structures.
- Write excerpts from our own plays as scripts.
- Write rhyming couplets.
- Write balanced arguments based on debate.

As **Mathematicians** we will

- Multiply fractions by integers and other fractions.
- Divide fractions by whole numbers.
- Work with decimals up to 3 decimal places
- Learn equivalences between fractions, decimals and percentages.
- Convert between fractions, decimals and percentages.
- Find fractions, decimals and percentages of amounts to solve problems.

As **Scientists** we will

- Explain the importance of the discovery of electricity.
- Research how electricity is produced.
- Make circuits with different components.
- Observe and explain the effects of different volts in a circuit on buzzers and bulbs
- Plan a game or quiz that incorporates these components.

As **Designers and Makers** we will

- Make a freestanding puppet stage.
- Design moveable scenery for our stage.
- Design costumes for characters.
- Evaluate and modify our products.



As **Artists** we will

- Study the life and works of Henry Moore
- Develop sketching techniques
- Sculpture study— Own interpretation of Henry Moore

As **Historians** we will..

- Learn about the Wars of the Roses and the formation of the House of Tudor.
- Study the historical importance of male heirs.
- Examine how religion changed in Tudor times.
- Examine evidence about the Spanish Armada
- Learn about the influence of Queen Elizabeth I
