As Readers we will.....

-Read a range of fiction books for pleasure and discuss and share ideas as a class.

-Develop our predictions skills and how we use evidence from the text to back up our ideas. As Writers we will.....

-Write our own stories based on a short version of Beowulf

-Write explanation texts about The Vikings

-Write a set of instructions about how to look after a dragon.

As Mathematicians we will

-Develop our number and place value knowledge

Look at solving missing number problems involving addition and subtraction
Learn to confidently find the perimeter and area of shapes.

As Scientists we will

-Look at a range of different forces and how they affect our everyday life.

-Conduct a range of experiments and learn how to measure different forces.

As Historians we will..

Take an in depth look at 'The Vikings'. We will explore where they came from, how they lived and the impact they have had on our world today.

We will develop our research skills by selecting appropriate resources and sources of evidence to find out information about them.
