10/1	Self-Control	Self Control Fruit of the Spirit	1 Corinthians 10:13	Talk about New Year resolutions, and how people try to use their self-control to improve an aspect of their life. Think about how people use positive statements in order to achieve this e.g 'I want to feel fit and healthy' rather than 'I mustn't eat too much.' 17/1	Generosity	Oswald Galter and Unconditional Love	1 John 3:16-18	Think about what being generous means, and how our first response is about giving something away. What can we be generous with? A first thought may be money, but we can be generous with anything we can share; our time, happiness, toys, skills, a smile, kind words etc. Give an example of some of these. 24/1	Symbols of Christianity	Christian Symbols	John 8:12	First, look at symbols in everyday life and how they represent something. Show some logos and get the children to talk about what they represent, and explain the link if they can. Christian symbols are very much like this, they remind us of something important about Christianity. This week look in closer detail at the cross, and the candle. This week focus on the fish, and bread and wine. What is the significance of the fish to us, what does it help us to remember? Talk about the importance of the bread and wine in the Eucharist, and how we see and hear this in church. Are there any further symbols that are part of Christianity? How do we show love towards each other on a daily basis. Collect some examples of people doing things because of love. Link to how we can show love for the world we have been given.
