22/4	St Georges Day Courage	Acts 4 Make the link that the men stood up for what they believed.	Deuteronomy <u>31:6-8</u>	Take ideas about what courage is, and its origins in the French word 'coeur' – heart. Talk about courage in terms of standing up for what you believe, in the face of doubt or fear. Although St George supposedly slayed a dragon, which took enormous courage, he stood up for what he believed when he was persecuted. Demonstrate courage with a <u>balloon. 28/4	Respect	Matthew 21:12-16 The children praise Jesus in the Temple	Matthew 7:12	Use the ideas from <u>Barnabas in Schools</u> to structure a demonstration of someone showing a lack of respect. Let this lead the discussion of how we should and do show respect. At the end, repeat the performance but challenge everyone to be as respectful as possible.
