(Andrew as Simon's brother). The name Jesus gave Simon was Peter, which means 'rock.' Reflect on how and why this name is appropriate. Think about what this tells us about trusting each other. Look at the idea of being fair versus having things our own way. Sometimes we all feel that things might not be fair. Read or act out The Tale of Two Brothers .
