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Dear Parents,

On Monday 29th September, Year 5 will be visiting the Hawk Conservancy Trust near Andover. This visit will enrich the pupils' learning of our current enquiry: How are you helping to protect our planet?

A visit to the Hawk Conservancy Trust offers pupils an unforgettable day of unique encounters with endangered species. Children will take part in a Conservation in Action workshop, enjoy spectacular flying displays, and join in with activities such as Nifty Nest Builders. These experiences will deepen their understanding of conservation and inspire them to think about how they can help protect our planet.

We will travel by coach, leaving school at 9:00 am. Pupils will need to bring a packed lunch, which will be eaten outside, with shelter available in case of bad weather. Please ensure your child has a waterproof coat. We expect to return for the end of school.

Thanks to the generous contribution from the Friends of St. Andrews, the cost of travel and admission has been kept to a minimum. The cost of the trip will be £20 per child to cover the expenses for this exciting trip.

Consent and payment can be completed online via the school app. On the day, children should wear their usual school uniform and bring a packed lunch and water. If your child receives free school meals, Mrs. Carpenter can provide a packed lunch upon request (please order by Monday 15th September).

We are very much looking forward to this exciting opportunity, which promises to be both educational and memorable for the children.
