

Dear Parents and Carers,

We are excited to let you know that we will be introducing **Class Dojo** across our school as a new way of strengthening communication between home and school and providing more opportunities to share your child's learning.

What is Class Dojo?

Class Dojo is a secure online platform, available both as a website and a free app, which allows teachers to share class news, reminders, and gives the opportunity to celebrate and showcase children's learning. Families will be able to connect to their child's class page and keep up to date with what is happening in school.

How we will be using Class Dojo

- Teachers will share learning, photos, and updates on the class page. Please note: if you have not given photo permission for your child, they will not appear in shared images.
- Class messages and reminders will also be posted on the class page, helping to keep you informed of upcoming events.
- Some classes may use Dojo points in school as part of our house point system. However, these points will not be visible to families at home.
- Once you are connected, you will be able to send messages to your child's teacher through the app. We kindly ask that messages are used considerately and for matters that cannot be addressed via the school office. Teachers will respond during the school day, when possible, but please understand they are not expected to reply during evenings, weekends, or holidays.

Next steps

Your child will shortly be receiving a personalised QR code which will connect you to your child's class page. We encourage you to download the Class Dojo app to make it as easy as possible to access updates and messages.

We are excited to be using Class Dojo to strengthen our home-school partnership and to celebrate the wonderful learning taking place in our classrooms.
