19/2	Lent Shrove Tuesday and Ash Wednesday	<u>What is Lent?</u> <u>Salisbury</u> <u>Pancake Race</u>	Today's reading is from the book of: <u>Matthew</u> <u>Chapter 6</u> <u>Verses 16-18</u>	Start by showing this year's pancake race at Salisbury Cathedral. What can we work out from it? When was it? Why did people take part? Ask children if they did anything to mark pancake day (Shrove Tuesday) during half term. Have a look at the video clip in the story column which explains Lent. Explain the temptation of Christ in the desert and how some Christians give something up to remind them of this.
26/2	I am The door.	<u>I am The Door</u> <u>Faith Through</u> <u>The Door</u>	Today's reading is from the book of: <u>John</u> <u>Chapter 10</u> <u>Verse 9</u>	Remind Children of the 3 'I am' sayings that we have looked at so far (bread of life, light of the world and good shepherd.)The hyperlinks in the story column show ideas that may be demonstrated to help explain this metaphor that Jesus used. The first may be used for KS1 and the second for KS2. Think about how doors, protect but also offer passage.
4/3	Mothers 10.3 (Gentleness) Fruit of the Spirit World Book Day 7.3	<u>Psalm 23</u> <u>Verses 1-3</u>	Today's reading is from the book of: <u>Titus</u> <u>Chapter 3</u> <u>Verse 2</u>	Psalm 23 is one of the most well-known psalms. Read the verse and look at images related to this alongside gentle music. How does this make us feel? The Psalm is calming because it reflects the gentle nature of God's love for us. Think of how a parent loves their child and compare this to God's love.
11/3	Science Week (8.3-17.3)	<u>l wonder</u> (AH has book)	Today's reading is	Look at the photo in the PowerPoint – what is the child looking at? Accept lots of answers. What

18/3	I am The True Vine	<u>The True Vine</u> <u>Explained</u>	Today's reading is from the book of: <u>John</u> <u>Chapter 15</u> <u>Verses 1-5</u>	Look at a picture of a grape vine in fruit and discuss the purpose of the parts. Think about how a gardener looks after these parts. Use the link on the left to explain the metaphor that Jesus used when he said "I am the Vine." Draw comparisons between the Vine, Jesus and God.
25/3	Easter	<u>Holy Week in</u> <u>Order</u>	Today's reading is from the book of: <u>Mark</u> <u>Chapter 8</u> <u>Verse 31</u>	This week is Holy Week. Recap the events of Holy Week: Palm Sunday (24/3), The Last Supper/ Maundy Thursday (28/3), Good Friday (29/3) and Easter Sunday (31/3). The link to the left gives each part of the story in the Biblically correct order and it may be useful to watch these through the week.
