See Bible reading	Today's reading is from the book of: <u>Matthew</u> <u>Chapter 6</u> <u>Verses 5-8</u> And <u>Verses9-14</u>	Key Stage Worship Materials In class worship try to learn the lines that are to the left, verbally and with <u>Makaton</u> . You could also try singing the version in the CW folder on Staff Share. Talk about ways that we can show respect for the Lord's name; what can we do and say to show that God's name is Holy?

Today's reading is from the book of: <u>Luke</u> <u>Chapter 17</u> <u>Verses 20-21</u>	Key Stage Worship Materials In class worship try to learn the lines that are to the left, verbally and with <u>Makaton</u> . You could also try singing the version in the CW folder on Staff Share. Think about the 3 lines in focus: how as Christians we believe that God's Kingdom is here on Earth and that we should do what Jesus taught us, to make God's kingdom on Earth more like His kingdom in Heaven.

The Angry Bee	Today's reading is from the book of: <u>Colossians</u> <u>Chapter 3</u> <u>Verse 13</u>	Key Stage Worship Materials In class worship try to learn the lines that are to the left, verbally and with <u>Makaton</u> . You could also try singing the version in the CW folder on Staff Share. Use a loaf of bread and talk about how we feel when we eat it. This line is about spiritual fulfilment, having what we need in in our lives to be content. Focus on forgiveness, why we should forgive and how it feels to be forgiven when we make a mistake. God forgives us when it happens.

Fighting Temptation	Today's reading is from the first book of: <u>Corinthians</u> <u>Chapter 10</u> <u>Verse 13</u>	Key Stage Worship Materials In class worship try to learn the lines that are to the left, verbally and with <u>Makaton</u> . You could also try singing the version in the CW folder on Staff Share. Think about times when we are tempted to do something that isn't right. God (the Holy Spirit) gives people the strength to do what is right and not to give in to temptation. Relate this to when Jesus was tempted in the desert. How can we be strong when we are tempted?	
13/5 KS2 SATS	For thine is the kingdom, the power and the glory,	<u>How can we</u> praise God?	Today's reading is from the book of: <u>Matthew</u> <u>Chapter 16</u> <u>Verse 19</u>	Key Stage Worship Materials In class worship try to learn the lines that are to the left, verbally and with <u>Makaton</u> . You could also try singing the version in the CW folder on Staff Share. This refers again to God's kingdom and giving thanks for it. The power and the glory relates to praising God. Think of all the ways that we praise God. Is it only in worship? When else and how else do we do this?	
20/5	For ever and ever, Amen	<u>Why do we</u> <u>pray?</u>	Today's reading is from the book of: <u>John</u> <u>Chapter 10</u> <u>Verse 28-30</u>	Key Stage Worship Materials In class worship try to learn the lines that are to the left, verbally and with <u>Makaton</u> . You could also try singing the version in the CW folder on Staff Share. Think about when the Lord's Prayer was said and written down, and the notion of eternity. Focus on the roots of the word 'Amen' in Hebrew being a word to express agreement. When we say this, we are asking for these things to happen.
