Dear Year 6 Parents

BIKEABILITY COURSE FOR YEAR 6 PUPILS

We are pleased to be able to offer the Bikeability Level 1 / 2 course to our Year 6 pupils again this year. The course will be led by two registered instructors over two full days. The first day is spent in and around school and the children will only go out onto the roads in Laverstock near the school. On the second day, children will be taken out all day by the instructors. On both days, children should wear comfortable clothes for cycling and bring a packed lunch.

We have two courses in the autumn term (maximum of 12 children per group). The Bikeability scheme charges a £5.30 administration charge for each pupil. For this, the children will receive badges and a pack at the end of the course. To undertake the course the children need a roadworthy cycle and a cycle helmet. The bikeability courses this year will run on:-

- Group 1: Wednesday 14 October and Thursday 15 October
- Group 2: Monday 9 November and Tuesday 10 November

We will allocate spaces on a first-come, first-served basis and confirm the dates for your child's course once we have filled all the spaces. We will then send you further paperwork for the course. Please pay using your SIMS Pay Account (www.st-andrews-laverstock.wilts.sch.uk – About Us – Online Payments). If you are unable to reply online, then please return the slip overleaf AND money to the office by return as spaces are limited. There is no need to return this slip if you are registering and paying online.

The deadline for all registrations is **28 September 2020**.
