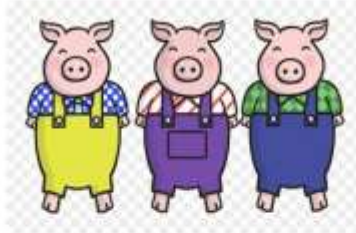




## Year 1 Parent Planner - Term 2 2020 Traditional Tales



### AREAS OF LEARNING



#### As **Mathematicians** we will...

- add and subtract numbers within 10 and 20.
- name and identify common 2D and 3D shapes.
- study place value within 10.– identifying the difference between tens and ones.
- Be secure with number bonds to both 10 and 20.

#### As **Scientists** we will ....

- identify and name a variety of everyday materials
- describe the properties of each material and group them accordingly.
- study the season of winter observing the changes in weather and the environment around us.

#### As **Readers** we will...

- read a variety of traditional tales— identifying similarities and differences between them.
- read adaptations of the Christmas story.
- enjoy lots a picture books from a range of authors.

#### As **Writers** we will...

- use Talk for Writing to help us learn and innovate the story of the 3 Little Pigs.
- write sentences using capital letters and full stops.
- create wanted posters for the wolf.

#### As **Artists** we will ....

- create fire work art
- learn about the work of sculpture artist Barbara Hepworth

#### As **Sportspeople** we will ...

- develop our 5 shapes in gymnastics and develop these shapes by adding apparatus.
- Please make sure that your child has a named P.E. kit in school at all times.**

#### As **Computer**

#### **Scientists** we will ....

- learn how to open a word document.
- type a sentence.
- change the text colour.

#### Homework

Each week the children will be set 1 mathletics task to complete and a list of spellings relating to the sound we have been looking at in phonics.

We have an app online, similar to mathletics, called spelling shed where your child's spellings will be set. They will have a log in code stuck on their reading log. You can access this online for free, or there is an option to buy the app.

If possible listen to your child read daily, as this will really help to develop their fluency and comprehension skills.
